I am returning herewith, without my approval, the following bills:

Senate Bill Number 3113-B, entitled:

VETO # 232 "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law and the state finance law, in relation to authorizing the issuance of license plates bearing the words 'Cure Childhood Cancer'"

Senate Bill Number 4993-B, entitled:

VETO # 233 "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to authorizing the issuance of distinctive license plates to severely disabled volunteer firefighters"

Senate Bill Number 5024-C, entitled:

VETO # 234 "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law and the state finance law, in relation to creating the veteran's outreach center distinctive license plate program and applying the revenues raised from such new program to the purposes of supporting the veteran's outreach center fund"

Senate Bill Number 6223-A, entitled:

VETO # 235 "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to authorizing the issuance of distinctive license plates for paid professional firefighters"

Senate Bill Number 6224-A, entitled:

VETO # 236 "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to creating a distinctive 'buy American' license plate"

Senate Bill Number 6427-A, entitled:

VETO # 237 "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to authorizing the issuance of distinctive 'Explore NY 400' license plates; and to amend the state finance law, in relation to establishing the 'Explore NY 400 fund'"

Senate Bill Number 6713-B, entitled:

VETO # 238 "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to providing for distinctive license plates for members of the Tenth Mountain Division of the United States Army"

Senate Bill Number 6748-A, entitled:

VETO # 239 "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to authorizing distinctive license plates for members of Kiwanis International"
